Can I ask you to point out to those concerned that swifts have seriously declined in recent years and are in danger of extinction unless we act now. The declines are because roof renovation and house demolition has resulted in loss of nesting places. Can you suggest that 3 swift nesting bricks used here would help this species to survive. The bricks are easy to fit, unobtrusive, inexpensive and will last the lifetime of the building. I am able to provide any further information needed.
