Dear Mr Priem

Having had chance to assess your application and review the submitted documentation, I am going to have to request some additional information as other than what is stated on your submission there is no clarification on:

- Whether the existing kerb will be retained;
- Is the excavated grass only limited to that outlined in the red box or the entire frontage;
- Is there going to be some sort of front boundary retained?

Please can you prepare a plan which demonstrates exactly what the frontage will look like/ consist off in order for us to be able to properly assess the full extent of the application.

Other than the area to facilitate to the new dropped kerb, the remaining grass verge should be retained and ideally some form of front boundary should be retained.

Just to clarify, the principle of the new dropped kerb is not an issue, it is just we do not have enough information at present to fully assess the changes this proposal would cause.
