The landscaping scheme relating to the development on plot D was submitted as part of application B/19/0050 and the 'landscape master plan' was included as part of the list of approved documents and plans within condition 2.

Condition 3 attached to this permission requires the landscaping to be carried out in accordance with the approved landscape masterplan 'within timescales that shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the LPA....'

The applicant intends to carry out the landscaping works for plot D within 6 months of occupation of the development. This is acceptable.
