The Boston Borough Council hereby certify that on 29-Apr-2021 the use described in the First Schedule to this Certificate in respect of the land specified in the Second Schedule to this Certificate and edged red on the plan attached, is lawful within the meaning of Section 192 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) for the following reasons:-

the Council is satisfied that the proposed removal of Kalvis Wood Pellet Boilers and installation of 14 Angus Eco Orlan Boilers does not require a planning application and under the provisions of S.192 of the Planning Act 1990, the proposed works are considered lawful for planning purposes.

- 2. This Certificate is issued solely for the purpose of Section 192 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).
- 3. It certifies that the use specified in the First Schedule taking place on the land described in the Second Schedule is lawful, on the specified date and, thus was not liable to enforcement action under Section 172 of 1990 Act on that date.
