- T2 Sycamore trim top 3m and prune sides
- T3 Ash trim top 2m and prune sides
- T4 Ash trim top 3m and prune sides
- T5 Ash trim top 3m and prune sides
- T6 Ash trim top 3m and prune sides
- T7 Ash trim top 2m and prune sides

All - remove ivy and general maintenance (removal of dead wood and broken branches)

In pursuance of their powers under the above mentioned Act and Regulations, Boston Borough Council as Local Planning Authority give consent for this proposal subject to the following conditions:-

- All works should be completed within two years of the date of this notice.
- This consent only allows for the identified works to be carried out once.
- All works should be carried out in accordance with the British Standard BS 3998:2010 Tree Work-Recommendations.
