Dear Mr Jones,

Application for works to trees within a conservation area to include:

Eucalyptus (T1) - Reduce by 50% due to damage to property
Mature Lime (T2) - Reduce crown by 25%, crown clean and raise
Limes (T3 & T4) - Crown raise and clean, reduce back branches growing over neighbour's drive
Willow (T5) - Remove self set to ground level
Poplar (T6) - Remove self set to ground level
Buddleja (T7) - Remove to ground level due to damage to property
Mature Beech (T8) - Crown raise & reduce crown spread to clear building
Ornamental Plum & Hawthorn (T9) - Reduce back to boundary as is growing over pavement at 55, Spilsby Road, Boston PE21 9NX

Further to my recent letter, I am pleased to be able to inform you that the Council has decided not to make a Tree Preservation Order in this case.

You may therefore go ahead with your proposal.

The works shall be undertaken in compliance with British Standard:
BS 3998:2010: Recommendations for Tree Works.

Please note that the proposed works should be carried out within 2 years from the date of this notice. If the works are not carried out within this time scale then you will be required to seek consent again from the Local Planning Authority.

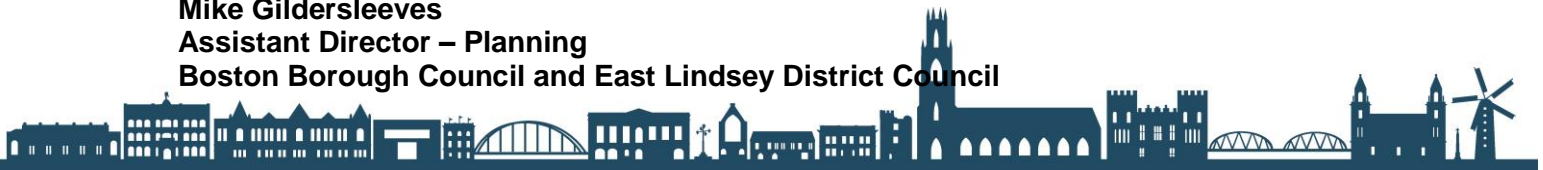
