Advice/Comments

This application is for the approval of reserved matters concerning access, appearance, landscaping, layout and scale of an outline approved dwelling. The application site is directly adjacent to a GII listed building.

Special attention must be given to the desirability of preserving or enhancing the setting of the Listed Building under Section 66 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

The drawings provided do not offer much detail on the proposed design of the dwelling. The following should be confirmed prior to determination:

<u>House:</u>

- What is the proposed ridge height of the house?
- The roof and wall materials have been confirmed. The Marley tile is acceptable, red brick is also acceptable but what kind of red brick? What brick bond is proposed? It is suggested that a garden bond is used as stretcher bond would not preserve the setting.
- It is assumed that stone lintels and sills are proposed on the front elevation? The rest of the windows/doors have no lintel details provided. What are these going to be/look like?
- There are no window or door drawings/material spec. What are the proposed windows and doors?
- There are no eaves details. Is the brickwork going to be stepped? Dentilled? Dogtooth? Etc.
- Is the front porch oak? What is the infill on the front gable of it?
- Rain water goods?

Garage:

- Is this brick or timber clad?
- What material is proposed for the roof? What is the ridge height?
- Are the doors timber? What window is proposed (materials etc.)?

When the above is provided it be judged whether the design conforms to section 66 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.
