T5- sycamore Reason for works,Reduce by half or fell its over crowded and leaning towards garden reducing light and will not make any good appear from reducing light every year.

T6- sycamore Reason for works, reduce or fell due to over crowded suffering and dying back This tree is on its way out and will fail in time.

T7- Sycamore Remove overhang to boundary reason for works lack of light to the garden.

Replant with trees with colour as its a very bland area for colour, the customers want a cherry and Will take on what else you require.
